- Emailed / faxed bids will not be accepted.

2 pm, Wednesday, August 16, 2023 - Bids publicly opened at the "Old Power Plant"

4 pm, Wednesday, August 16, 2023 - Notice of Award will be issued to successful bidders.

Noon, Friday, August 18, 2023 - Payment must be received by this time in guaranteed form (cash, cashier's check, electronic bank transfer) or Notice of Award will be invalidated and NJUS may move to the next highest bidder.

Noon, Wednesday, August 23, 2023 - Purchased vehicles must be removed from NJUS / City property or will be considered abandoned.
