NJUS is accepting applications for a position in the Line Department

As a **JOURNEYMAN LINEMAN**:

Position: **JOURNEYMAN LINEMAN**

Salary Range: \$34.34/hour, plus negotiated union benefits

-or-

Position: **APPRENTICE LINEMAN**

Salary Range: \$17.17 – 22.50/hour, plus negotiated union benefits

Additional 5% increment every 1000 documented apprentice hours to 100% scale
(upon receiving Journeyman-Lineman license)

Hours: Permanent, full time – 40 hours/week

This recruitment is seeking candidates who possess a State of Alaska Certificate of Fitness as a Journeyman-Lineman. NJUS will also consider applications from candidates who desire to consider Nome as home who can start as an Apprentice Lineman, gaining experience with the NJUS system working under the supervision of a Journeyman. If the selected candidate is an Apprentice, he/she will be required to enroll and be accepted in the IBEW Apprenticeship Program and attend classes outside of Nome for periods in Fairbanks or Anchorage.

Requirements for position:

- High school diploma (or equivalent/GED)
- Valid Alaska Driver License with CDL endorsement (or not be disqualified from/have the ability to obtain CDL endorsement)
- Experience and proficiency in operating mechanized equipment (boom trucks, diggers, backhoe, etc.)
- Working knowledge of the standard methods, practices, tools and equipment of the electrical trade
- Possess mechanical aptitude required to maintain system components
- Ability to read and interpret system plans, sketches or one-line diagrams, and manuals
- Ability to make mathematical computations, accurately read and record system operational data, and possess general computer knowledge (Microsoft Word & Excel)
- Ability to work following standard safety practices
- Ability to work independently, with other employees, and under time constraints
- Must have excellent written and oral communications skills and ability to maintain productive working relationships
- Possess good public relations skills and ability to work with the public
- Physical ability to lift at least 70#
- May require work in inclement weather conditions, and also outside regularly scheduled hours on a call-out basis
