IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

Applicant is bound by the following rules and regulations of Nome Joint Utility System (NJUS) as contained in the Nome Code of Ordinances (NCO) Chapter 15 and further outlined in adopted Tariffs. Tariffs currently in effect are: Tariff No. 2 – Electricity and NJUS Tariff No. 3 – Water and Sewer.

Copies of the Nome Code of Ordinances and complete Tariffs are available for review during regular business hours at the following locations: NJUS Customer Service Office (City Hall), office of the Utility Manager or office of the Nome City Clerk.

1. DEPOSIT FOR UTILITY SERVICE - ESTABLISHMENT OF CREDIT

The applicant shall deposit with the Utility an amount not exceeding the estimated sum of two months' billings for the utility service(s) requested for the customer's service location (Ordinance 15.20.030(a)) unless the customer has a good credit history with NJUS. If the applicant has had prior history of good credit rating (not delinquent in payment more than once in any twelve consecutive months) from another similar (electric-water-sewer) utility continually for a period of two years. Upon review of a letter of credit from the utility offered by the applicant, we will determine if it may satisfy some or all of our credit requirements (resulting in no deposit being required or accepting a reduced deposit).

The deposit will be refunded at the end of two years (or sooner if the applicant discontinues service), provided the applicant has not been delinquent more than once in any twelve (12) consecutive month period and the Utility has not been forced to disconnect that customer's service for reasons of delinquency in payment of charges. When service is terminated earlier, any portion of the deposit not required to pay balances owed the Utility, will be refunded to the applicant within twenty (20) days.

2. BILLING AND PAYMENT

The initial billing period shall start when applicant begins receiving utility services. The regular billing period is from the 15th to the 15th.

The applicant shall pay the Utility for services at the rates and upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Utility schedules of rates and charges. The applicant shall pay to the Utility not less than \$5.00 per month for a service or for having service available.

Bills for service shall be paid at the Customer Service Office at the Nome City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 102 Division Street, Nome. Such payments shall be due the 25th day of each month for service provided during the preceding month billing period. Payments must be received by the due date; if mailed, post mark date does not control.

If the applicant should fail to make any such payment within 15 days after such payment is due, the Utility may disconnect service to the applicant upon giving 48 hours notice of its intentions to do so. However, such discontinuance of service shall not relieve the applicant of any payment obligations. All customers that receive the 48 hour disconnect notice will be charged a \$18.00 fee for the cost of serving notice.

3. CONTINUITY OF SERVICE

The Utility shall use reasonable diligence to provide a constant and uninterrupted utility service. If the supply of utility services should fail or be interrupted, or become defective through an act of God, Governmental authority, action of the elements, public enemy, accident, strikes, labor trouble, required maintenance work, inability to secure right-of-way, or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Utility, the Utility shall not be liable therefore or for damages caused thereby. CUSTOMERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO INSTALL UNINTERRUPTIBLE POWER SUPPLY (UPS) UNITS OR SURGE SUPPRESSORS ON SENSITIVE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT.

4. RIGHT OF ACCESS

Duly authorized representatives of the Utility shall be permitted to enter the consumer's premises at all reasonable times in order to carry out Tariff provisions.
